OSSLT

The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) measures whether students are meeting the minimum standard for literacy across all subjects up to the end of Grade 9. This year, the Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO) will be offering the computer-based online OSSLT to eligible students across the province. Successful completion of this literacy test is one of the requirements to earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

On November 14th, eligible grade 11 and non-graduating grade 12 students will be taking part in the OSSLT at Hillcrest HS. If eligible, your child will be scheduled to write the OSSLT and will receive a personalized invitation on Nov 2nd. If your student does not get an invitation, and they have not yet completed the OSSLT requirement, please have them see their guidance counsellor.

We will be offering in-person practice sessions on Nov 7th.

Grade 10 students will be writing the OSSLT in the Spring. More details to come about this later.


Parent/Guardian Post-Secondary Application Presentation, Oct 26th.
