Final Evaluations / Exams

Final Evaluation / Exam Days began today, Wednesday, January 24th and end on Tuesday, January 30th. Expectations for students will vary by course and grade level.

On these mornings, students may have an exam (Grade 11 and 12 only), a task/interview, or other optional opportunities for all students to improve their achievement.

Should final evaluations/exams be postponed because of inclement weather, the "bump and slide" principle will apply; each day's exam/task will be written one day later than originally scheduled. Should this occur, students must be available to write all of their exams. Official inclement weather days occur when all school buses are cancelled in the OCDSB.

- The delay was caused by a staffing issue with Chartwell's who are the organization that provides cafeteria services throughout the board. This has now been resolved.
